We have returned from Belize and have good news to share with you. Our meeting with Ms. Pennill in the Department of Human Services in Belize was completely successful!

First we gave her a portfolio of Tabitha International, showing our credentials and history in Belize. Next we presented her with sample resources that are used in the foster care program in Colorado. Finally we showed her a video presentation we had made interviewing Jill Welt from Boulder County Social Services Foster/Adopt Care Department. (Jill is one of three Social Services employees who have volunteered to do teaching seminars on video that will be used in training sessions for the Foster/Adopt parents of Belize.) Ms. Pennill was elated with what she saw and heard. She expressed her excitement about our coming and working together to build a Foster/Adopt training program and asked that we begin this work immediately through email. Her desire is that we hold training sessions two times per year, per district. With six districts that means one session per month.

With that accomplishment behind us, we traveled north to Corozal. Through the lead of a Baptist Missionary couple we know living in Belize we met a "Missions to the World" missionary family in Corozal and they gave us helpful information on housing and the area. Corozal is just south of the Mexican border and has many Belizean Hispanic families. We are told that it is a quiet town with less crime. We believe it will be perfect for Tabitha International's headquarters.

We feel very encouraged and blessed. God is clearly opening doors for us. Please pray as we now continue our fund raising and gear up for our move in the spring. Thank you for your prayers and for being part of this exciting ministry.
